CHILDRENS' CHRISTMAS PARTY

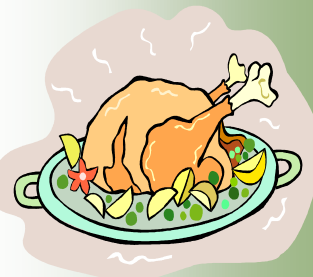
The format has been changed this year. Come in and sign up for receiving the Childrens' gifts. The age limit to receive gifts has been reduced to 12 years of age.

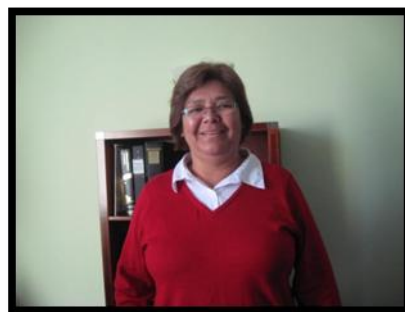
