

Job Description – Subsurface Technician

Role Description:

Reporting to the Field Supervisor, Subsurface Technicians use a variety of methods and equipment to locate, mark and record sub-surface features in multiple settings.

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Operate electromagnetic induction locating equipment with all accessories.
- Operate magnetic bar finder.
- Open sewers and catch basins to measure inverts and obverts.
- Keep accurate records (timesheet, tickets, expenses, etc.)
- Retrieve project information from email and Synergy website and plan work.
- Drive vehicle and optimize route.
- Travel to other cities/areas, work in a variety of settings and worksite conditions.
- Work evenings, weekends or out-of-town on occasion.
- Read project sheets.
- Read, interpret and augment maps with notes.
- Operate a PC.
- Create locate sketches.
- Take photos of locates and upload to server monthly.
- Other duties as required.
